MPH (Miles Per Hour) – Wind Rating

- ✓ This tells you about wind capacity for your building structure.
- ✓ Example: 120 MPH, 140 MPH, 170 MPH.
- ✓ Based on wind speed from storms/hurricanes.
- ✓ Engineered certified for your county codes..



REAL MEANING

>>> Higher MPH = stronger structure

>>> Includes:

- Frame strength
- Anchoring system
- Roof & wall panels
