CERTIFICATION: MPH and PSF

PSF (Pounds per Square Foot) - Snow Load

- ✓ This tells you how much weight the roof can hold.
- ✓ Example: 20 PSF, 30 PSF, 40 PSF.
- ✓ Measures snow (or any weight) on the roof.



REAL MEANING

>>> Higher PSF = stronger roof system.

>>> Prevents:

- Roof sagging
- Collapse under snow

>>> In most southern states:

- 0-20 PSF is common

Northern states:

- 30-70+ PSF
